Thank you for your interest in cooperation with Drehmo GmbH. With this data protection declaration, we would like to inform you what personal data will be gathered within the framework of our services, and for what purpose this data will be used to optimise our services for you.

1. Controller

2. What information will Drehmo collect about me?

Drehmo commits itself to the principles of data economy. Personal data are only collected and stored by us if you grant your active and voluntary consent, for example within the framework of signing up for the Drehmo services or when sending documents like applications, requests or other correspondence.

All available personal data collected during the visit of our websites are only processed within the framework of the respectively valid regulations for protecting personal data and only for the purpose of the services requested by you and for processing your requests.

3. For what purpose does Drehmo use my personal data?

Basically, Drehmo processes your personal data only for the purpose the data was received or collected for.

Processing or use of this data for other purposes shall only be made following your explicit consent for such use.

4. Which is the legal basis for the processing?

The legal basis for processing personal data is basically governed – unless there are other specific legal prescriptions – by article 6 of the EU General Data Protection Regulation. The following options apply in particular:

- Consent
- Data processing for fulfilling contracts

- Data processing on the basis of consideration of interests
- Data processing for fulfilling legal obligations

If your personal data is processed on the basis of consent, you have the right to withdraw your consent at any time.

If the data are processed on the basis of a consideration of interests, you have the right to withdraw the consent for processing at any time.

5. What is the storage period for the data?

Drehmo shall store your personal data only for the period required for the respective purpose.

Should legal storage deadlines exist, the data shall be stored for the period of storage obligation. After expiry of this period, the further requirement for processing shall be examined. If there is no requirement, the data shall be erased.

6. To which recipients will the data be disclosed?

Drehmo will not disclose your personal data to third parties without your consent, except where disclosure is required by law. Should Drehmo order third parties to process personal data, for example providers of external storage solutions or Cloud service providers, we assure that such an order processing will be performed in compliance with data protection based on the applicable national laws and regulations adopted at European level. Order processing service providers are selected with utmost care by us and compliance with technical and organisational measures taken by the contractor will be checked and recorded by AUMA.

When transferring personal data to a member of group outside of the EU or the EEA (so called third countries), we shall provide an adequate level of data protection by means of contractual agreements.

7. Data protection and data security

Drehmo deploys technical and organisational security measures to protect the data gathered from you against manipulation, loss, destruction as well as against unauthorised access. All information is transmitted in encrypted form. Users may only access order related data for disclosure of which the user is entitled. Our security measures are continuously improved in compliance with the latest technical developments.

Our employees are obliged to treat all data as confidential and to maintain data secrecy. The obligation to observe data secrecy shall persist after termination of their employment at Drehmo.

8. Tools

8.1 Google Maps

For using functions of Google Maps, your IP address must be stored. Generally, this information is disclosed to and stored with the Google server in the US. The service provider of this page has no influence on data disclosure.

Google Maps is used for the purpose of a more attractive presentation of our online services and easier geolocalisation of the locations indicated on our website. This complies with the purposes of the legitimate interests according to article 6 para. 1 alinea f of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).
